Love Your Neighbor Activity Download

Instructions—This game is not only fun and allows the girls to interact with one another, but it also provides a great lead into how we love one another. Is it conditional? Is it biased? Does it reflect Christ's love?

PREPARATION: Get enough chairs to have one for each participant then remove one chair and arrange the chairs in a circle.

1. Sit the group in a circle.
2. Stand in the center of the circle, and ask one person in the group "Do you love your neighbor."
3. The person you ask can give either of two possible responses: 1) "Yes" and then the youth on her right and left must switch seats. OR 2) They can say "no but I love everyone who..." has brown hair, is wearing blue, has been water skiing, name starts with K...
4. Everyone who meets the characteristic has to get up and change seats to a new seat.
5. While people are changing seats the person in the center of the circle tries to grab one of the empty chairs.
6. Whoever is left without a seat get to repeat the process of asking someone in the circle "Do You Love Your Neighbor?"
