The Price is Right Activity Download

PREPARATION: Get 3-5 items to have for display. Items should vary in category and value. (Example: Piece of Jewelry, Figurine, Autographed Ball Etc)

1. Have the items on Display when the girls arrive.
2. Have the girls evaluate one of the items and write down their estimated value.
3. Do this for all items
4. Beginning with the first item, have each girl announce their price. Do this for all the items.
5. At the end, instead of reveling what the item is actually worth—highlight how each girl had a different answer for each item.

Do you see that each person placed a different value on the items presented? So many different factors play a role in how you came up with the value of an item. Things such as: whether you liked the object or whether you had ever seen something similar. This is much like how we operate with our relationships. We let emotions, selfish desires and other things cloud our view of seeing people how God sees them. Here's the good news, God does not operate that way. In this week's chapter we were reminded that we are just as valuable to God as someone else. No stipulations or strings attached. Understanding this and the importance of looking to God to feel valuable is part of this journey. Chose not to let other people determine your value, but God alone.
